## KREMMLING SANITATION DISTRICT

REGULAR BOARD MEETING  
JULY 8, 2019

The Board of Directors for the Kremmling Sanitation District met in the boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. The meeting was called to order by President Jason Bock at 6:00 p.m. Directors present: Jason Bock, Dave Sammons, Dwayne Uhrich, Eric Bradley and Ken Bentler. Director(s) absent: None. Staff present: Superintendent Jeremy Bock and District Manager Rich Rosene. Audience present: None.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** UHRICH MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF JUNE 10, 2019 AS PRESENTED. BRADLEY SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED.

**APPROVAL OF EXPENDITURES:** BRADLEY MOVED TO APPROVE THE EXPENDITURES PRESENTED FOR THE PERIOD OF JUNE 10, 2019 THROUGH JULY 8, 2019 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$27,940.19. SAMMONS SECONDED. MOTION CARRIED.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** None.

**ENGINEER'S REPORT:** None.

**OPERATOR'S REPORT:** Bock said that Wastewater Compliance Systems (WCS) was up last week to video inside the domes of Pond C as it was not performing as well as expected. It was found to be because it was short of air. Pressure gauges were installed to determine where valves should be set to get more air there. The valves to Pond B were gated down to allow more air to Pond C. WCS will get a compressor to blow out the lines for better air flow.

The bump in Pond D is actually the liner rising up. Bock is trying to decide the best way to get it pushed down and may try some concrete blocks on the area. This is the shallowest pond and part of the problem may be air forced there from the reuse ponds getting full.

The jetting is done to the area of Kum and Go. He has had a few calls about muddy water or no water in the toilet. There haven't been any serious issues. The jetting should be done in about two weeks.

The sprinkler system at the plant has been working well. The town square and cemetery systems are also working well. The filter for the reuse line has been disconnected and the water flows straight through. What little algae or other particles get through will not cause any problems with the sprinklers. Some zone valves may get stuck, but they are easy to clean and get back into service.

President Bock asked if either Rosene or Superintendent Bock can attend a town board meeting to explain the possibility of extending the reuse water to Ceriani Park. Both will be unavailable for the next board meeting, but will get with the town manager to find a good date.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Rosene said that the annual eligibility survey filed with CDPHE has been submitted and has mostly projects we have submitted in the past, but with updated cost estimates. The total estimate is \$2.1 million for the next 10 years.

Rosene said that the draft 2018 audit has been completed and is being reviewed by one of the partners. The lead auditor on our audit is out on maternity leave. Rosene should get it in the next week or two for review and then it will be finalized and submitted to the state auditor's office.
