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TOWN OF KREMMLING  
REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING  
March 17, 2021

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the Boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Grover Pryor called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Due to COVID-19, this meeting was held via Zoom and in person for the Board. Trustees present: Jim Miller, Wes Howell, Leo Pesch, Dave Sammons. Staff present: Town Manager Dan Stoltman, Police Chief Hiram Rivera. Absent: Erik Woog and Jason Wikberg, and Town Clerk (position vacant)

SAMMONS MOVED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 17, 2021. PESCH SECONDED. ALL “AYE” VOTES.

HOWELL MOVED TO APPROVE EXPENDITURES DATED FEBRUARY 18, 2021 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2021 FOR A TOTAL OF \$287,269.76 SAMMONS SECONDED. ALL “AYE” VOTES.

SAMMONS MOVED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA DATED MARCH 17, 2021. PESCH SECONDED. ALL “AYE” VOTES.

**Discussion and Action** – Resolution 2021-2 Grand County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update – Town manager Stoltman gave an overview of the topic. No further discussion was had. A motion was made by Sammons to approve Resolution 2021-2, second by Pesch, motion passed unanimously.

**Discussion and Action** – Vector Disease Control International Mosquito Management Services Contract- Town Manager Stoltman gave an overview of last years operations and discussed the increase in cost for the 2021 season. Sammons asked to have the employees on the ground working for Vector Disease Control to check in with the Town manager to give updates on their activities. A motion was made by Sammons to approve the 2021 contract with Vector Disease Control for mosquito management services as presented, second by Howell. Motion passed unanimously.

**Discussion and Action** – Resolution 2021-3 “Meat-in Day”- Trustee Miller introduced the resolution. No further discussion took place. A motion was made by Howell to approve Resolution 2021-3, second by Pesch. Motion passed unanimously.

**Alcohol Licensing Matters-** The Moose Cafe Annual License Renewal – Town Manager and Chief of Police Rivera had no issues with the applicant. No further discussion was had. A motion was made by Sammons to approve liquor license number 41-33999-0000 Moose Café, second by Pesch. Motion passed unanimously.

**Adjourn** – A motion was made by Howell to adjourn at 6:30 pm, second by Sammons. Motion passed unanimously.
