

RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

TOWN OF KREMMLING
TOWN BOARD MEETING
February 2, 2022

The Board of Trustees, for the Town of Kremmling, met in the Boardroom located at 200 Eagle Avenue. Mayor Grover Pryor called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Due to COVID-19, this meeting was held via Zoom and in person for the Board. Mayor Grover Pryor present. Trustees present: Jim Miller, Wes Howell, Doug Prewitt, Erik Woog, Dave Sammons, and Leo Pesch. Staff present: Town Manager Dan Stoltman and Town Clerk Cassidy Bradley.

WOOG MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE REGULAR TOWN BOARD MINUTES DATED JANUARY 19, 2022. PREWITT SECONDED. ALL “AYE” VOTES.

SAMMONS MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE AGENDA DATED FEBRUARY 2, 2022. HOWELL SECONDED. ALL “AYE” VOTES.

Public Comments: David Buckley, a Kremmling resident, introduced himself as a candidate for Grand County Commissioner District 3. He invited the board and citizens to the March 1, 2022 precinct caucus and would like to be featured in the February 16th regular meeting for a Q&A discussion forum.

Planning and Zoning Commission Seat Appointment – Trustee Woog motions to appoint Alan Hassler to the Planning & Zoning Commission. Sammons seconded. All “aye” votes.

Discussion and Action- Parks and Recreation Coordinator- Manager Stoltman reviewed a proposal from previous meeting of a new position for a Parks and Recreation with the update of being full time year round at the boards suggestion. Suggested edits include to change “May be required to run mowers and weed eaters” to “Will be require...”, and increasing the “ability to lift 25 ponds” to “50 pounds”. Woog motioned to approve the Full Time Year Round position of Parks and Recreation Coordinator with the suggested edits and starting salary range of \$45,000-\$55,000. Howell seconded. All “aye” votes.

Alcohol Licensing Matters- Kremmling Area Chamber of Commerce Special Event License – Town Manager and Chief of Police Rivera had no issues with the applicant. Date includes March 5, 2022. A motion was made by Pesch to approve Special event Liquor License for March 5, 2022, seconded by Sammons. Aye votes from Howell, Prewitt, Woog, Sammons and Pesch. Nay vote from Miller. Motion passes.

Discussion – Future Agenda Items- Board discussed future agenda items they would like to see or review including: the path from the Liquor Store to the Mercantile, RFP for Pavillion replacement at Town Square, repairs in alleys, business licenses and who is required to have one, etc. taff will include items on future agendas.

Adjourn – A motion was made by Sammons to adjourn, seconded by Miller. Motion passed unanimously.
