


Discussion and Action- Sales Tax Exemption Request for Middle Park Fair and Rodeo - Middle Park Fair and Rodeo presented a request for a sales tax exemption for their annual fundraising events. The board discussed a long term sales tax exemption for Middle Park Fair and Rodeo. Sammons motioned to grant Middle Park Fair and Rodeo the exemption. Howell seconded. All "aye" votes.

Alcohol Licensing Matters- Middle Park Fair and Rodeo – Middle Park Fair and Rodeo request a special events liquor license for the following dates: May 7, 2022, June 10, 2022, and August 1-7, 2022. Town Manager and Chief of Police Rivera had no issues with the applicant. A motion was made by Howell to approve the Special Event Liquor Licenses to Middle Park Fair and Rodeo for all dates requested, seconded by Pesch. All aye votes.
